 - Exhaust gasket, AP5300
 - Top plate and linkage kit AP5224
 - Air cleaner adapter ARC6931

 - Noram RC series clutch only
 - Chain guard AP1785

Rule Changes - The following rule changes have been proposed.

Current Rule: After the race is started, any kart that drops out must be pushed off the track and no attempt may be made to restart and re-enter the race. Only after the race is completed may a kart be pushed or pulled back to the pits. Corner workers may help JUNIOR I DRIVERS ONLY. No motor restarts are allowed in any class

Proposed Rule: After the race is started, any kart that drops out must be pushed off the track. Corner workers may help JUNIOR I DRIVERS ONLY.

Current Rule: SKRA will allow only the following tires. No substitutions will be allowed:
DUNLOP SL 3 –SL4, BRIDGESTONE YFC-YGC-YHC, MAXXIS SLC-SLD-HG3, BURRIS, VEGA BLUE

Proposed Rule: S: SKRA will allow only Bridgestone YKC tires for four-cycle classes. Bridgestone YKC and Mojo tires will be allowed for two-cycle and shifter classes.
